 - Faculty Meetings Each week all faculty meet to stay up to date with events, classes, and students, as well as to stay in line with the institutes structure, order and protocol.
 - Choreography Lab This weekly class is for the entire dance school to meet special guests, show their work to peers, and perform.
 - Mentorship A number of times during each semester I meet with 7 students regarding their progress academically, creatively, personally and professionally.

- Hip Hop/Street Technique This course engaged in the study of Hip Hop/Street dance including but not limited to breaking, party dances, popping, locking and house ranging from the 1970s to the present within African diasporic communities. Through understanding the dances' cultural identities, innovators and pioneers, students then learned vocabulary, foundation, anatomy and behavior characteristics. Through movement practice, corresponding assignments via documentaries, readings, music, videos, and class discussions, students developed a well rounded perspective on the ever evolving culture of Hip Hop/Street dance.
- Hip Hop/Street Composition In this course students examined their foundational understanding of Hip Hop/Street dance and how it translated into choreographic practice and development. By viewing and discussing a variety of readings, and videos from notable choreographers, students created dances of their own inspired by prompts specific to principles in Hip Hop/Street dance and culture.
- Hip Hop/Street Repertory This course consisted of a variety of choreographic prompts inspired by my artistic body of work in dance on film including *Jonah*, *Blood Memory*, *and Boat* (seen in my portfolio).

- Course In-Development: Hip Hop Party Dances This course focuses on the practice of Hip Hop Party Dances (aka Social Dances) ranging from the 1970s to the present from Miami's Cabbage Patch to Atlanta's Renegade. After understanding the dances' cultural identities, innovators and pioneers, students will comprehend the movement vocabulary, followed by its musicality, rhythm and anatomy, thus concluding with the most important element: free-styling. Through movement practice, corresponding assignments via documentary, readings, music, and class discussions, students will develop a well rounded perspective on the ever evolving culture of Hip Hop within African-American vernacular dance. As students progress through the course, their solid base will enable them to build a more developed, experimental and stylistic aesthetic in their own movement practice.
- Faculty Meetings Weekly faculty and staff meetings to stay up to date with events, courses, and students, as well as to revisit and update the institutes structure, order and protocol at large.
- Choreography Lab This weekly time was for the entire dance school to congregate and share new works-in-progress, explore new creative ideas as well as to allow for special guests classes.
- Mentorship Every other week on average I met with up to seven undergrad and/or graduate students to discuss their progress throughout the semester academically, creatively, personally and professionally.
